



Andrew and Lilly Tsubaki Award

Award Criteria

This award is designed to be a supplement for a Theatre student who plans to participate in a study abroad program devoted to Theatre and/or language and culture of a foreign country. No student can receive this award more than twice while s/he is in the same degree program (undergraduate, M.A., or Ph.D.).

First Priority: Japanese students from Japan majoring in Theatre who have completed a minimum of one year on campus.

Second Priority: Students who have been admitted to a study abroad program for the coming academic year. Priority will be given to these candidates in the following order:

- a. Students participating in the KU Greek Summer Theatre Program.
- b. Students going to study in Japan.
- c. Students going to any overseas program hosted by KU.
- d. Students going to any overseas program hosted by an accredited institution.

Further specific criteria: The candidate must maintain a 3.0 cumulative G.P.A. and a 3.5 G.P.A. in the Theatre major. (A student who demonstrates outstanding talent in acting or scenography and maintains a 2.8 cumulative G.P.A. and a 3.3 G.P.A. in the Theatre major can also be considered.)
